Infant is involved in activities and with materials that stimulate their visual, sensorial awareness, fine and gross motor skills and language development in a warm and nurturing environment.

Toddler participates in activities with materials that support their total development, including increasing their attention span, fine and gross motor skills, language, social and creativity.

Miami-Dade Division of Child Development Services serves children from birth to 5 years of age.

Miami-Dade Office of Community and Economic Development provided funding for renovation of facilities to serve children birth to five years of age.

Reading is Fundamental provides funding for books for children.

USDA Food and Nutrition Management provides breakfast, lunch, and afternoon snacks to all enrolled children.
